



CREDENTIAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS







For best protection, keep credential in the clear-ridged card holder at all times. Avoid storing credential in wallets or carrying it loose in purses (without holder) to prevent the credential from becoming bent, folded, excessively scratched, or being damaged in other ways.



Avoid Direct Sunlight, UV Light, Excessive Temperatures

Do not leave credential in direct sunlight, ultraviolet light, or in an enclosed environment with temperatures of 80°F or higher. An 80°F-day can get up to 105°F inside a vehicle which can cause a credential to warp, melt, fade, or change color if the credential is left on the dashboard or vehicle seat.



Avoid Hazardous Conditions and Environments

- Do not leave credential in areas where it can come in contact with hot surfaces, chemicals or submerged in liquids.
- Do not wash credential in dishwasher or clothes washer.
- Do not put credential in the freezer, refrigerator, microwave or oven.





CREDENTIAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS



Clean Regularly

Clean credential with damp cloth using mild soap and warm water as often as needed (approx. once a month or more depending on usage).

DO NOT SUBMERGE credential in water or in any liquids



Remove Stains

For tough dirt and other stains that will not come clean with mild soap, use 99% isopropyl alcohol on a cotton ball/pad or cloth (once a month or as needed).

NOTE: Not all stains can be removed.
